- → In August 2025, Israel's Foreign Ministry ordered emergency aid to South Sudan, including medical kits, hygiene supplies, and food packages, to fight a cholera outbreak. Israeli MFA, Aug 21 2025
- → Since 1953, the IDF has carried out 37 humanitarian missions around the globe from Greece and Haiti to Nepal, Japan, and Turkey setting up field hospitals, rescuing thousands, and treating tens of thousands of victims. - → During the **2023 Turkey earthquakes**, Israel's *Olive Branches* delegation rescued 19 people and treated 470 patients in a full-scale field hospital. <u>IDF.gov.il</u>, 2023
- → In **March 2025**, Israel sent elite search-and-rescue teams and advanced equipment to **Thailand** within hours of a 7.7-magnitude quake near Myanmar. <u>Jerusalem Post</u>, <u>Apr 1 2025</u>
- → Over the decades, Israel has aided over 60 countries including Muslim and Christian nations alike from Rwanda and Kosovo to Haiti, Japan, and Greece. <u>Jerusalem Post, Apr 1 2025</u>
- → Even within Israel, programs like **Save a Child's Heart** show how Israeli hospitals routinely care for Palestinian and Arab patients regardless of politics or conflict. The organization has treated over 6,000 children from 65 countries—including 3,000 Palestinian children from Gaza, Judea and Samaria, and East Jerusalem—many from nations with no diplomatic ties to Israel.
