

Storytime With Hamas: Featuring Ms. Rachel

The Lie:

- Ms. Rachel loves *all* children - she can't be Antisemitic!

The Truth:

- Ms. Rachel may have a beloved children's TV show, but that does not make her immune from scrutiny when she spreads misinformation, aligns with Hamas-linked networks, or amplifies rhetoric rooted in modern blood libel.

Background:

- In December 2025, Ms. Rachel was named as a finalist for *Antisemite of the Year* by watchdog group, Stop Antisemitism, after over two years of spreading anti-Israel misinformation, elevating Hamas-aligned voices, and dismissing Jewish concerns.
- Her public persona as a gentle children's educator has shielded her from scrutiny — even as her rhetoric has reached millions and helped mainstream antisemitic narratives.

Truth Explained

- **She became a spokesperson for the Palestine Children's Relief Fund (PCRF), a U.S. nonprofit with extensive Hamas-linked partnerships.** PCRF operates inside **Al-Rantisi Children's Hospital in Gaza City**, where the IDF uncovered a Hamas military compound beneath the pediatric ward — including explosives, suicide vests, operational materials, and one of the **motorcycles used to carry out the attacks on October 7**. PCRF collaborates with Hamas-run ministries and extremist **Zakat committees** — “charitable” bodies repeatedly identified by Western authorities as financial pipelines for Hamas. - **Ms. Rachel repeated the false UN claim that “14,000 babies will die in 48 hours,” despite corrections.** The real UN projection estimated **14,100 severe malnutrition cases over 11 months**, not 48 hours. BBC and PBS corrected the error. - **She amplified a staged “starving baby” photo and blamed Israel for intentional child starvation.** The child suffered from a congenital disorder and the photo was staged.
