

## Marwan Barghouti is NOT the “Palestinian Nelson Mandela”

- Father Tsibouksakis Germanus, 35, was murdered on June 12, 2001, by gunmen using weapons Barghouti supplied near Jericho. ([Ministry of Foreign Affairs](#))
- Yoela Hen, 45, was murdered on January 15, 2002, while stopping for gas outside Jerusalem by terrorists acting on Barghouti’s orders. ([Ministry of Foreign Affairs](#))
- Three civilians were killed and over 30 wounded in the March 5, 2002, Seafood Market suicide bombing in Tel Aviv, which Barghouti ordered and coordinated through the Al-Aqsa Martyrs' Brigades. ([Ministry of Foreign Affairs](#))
- Barghouti admitted he directed terror operations for Yasser Arafat, providing money, weapons, and instructions to militants carrying out shootings and bombings. ([Los Angeles Times](#)), ([Aish](#))
- He founded Tanzim, Fatah’s armed faction, and later created the Al-Aqsa Martyrs’ Brigades, responsible for widespread terror attacks on civilians during the Second Intifada. ([Ministry of Foreign Affairs](#))
