

The Epstein-Israel Conspiracy That Doesn't Exist

The Lie

Jeffrey Epstein was a Mossad agent who used his elite sex-trafficking ring to blackmail politicians on behalf of Israel.

The Truth

Background

Truth Explained

- Former Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Barak met Epstein in 2003 and visited him dozens of times over several years. Barak never denied having a business relationship with Epstein. ([The Times of Israel](#)), ([The Cradle](#))

Takeaway

Jeffrey Epstein's crimes were personal and criminal—not political.
